- ❖ *Established in 1994 Sr. Emelia is the present Nurse Sister. Todey is located in Block 11 Kalimpong sub-division of Darjeeling District. It takes 5 hours by jeep to reach Todey from Kalimpong.*

- ❖ Ante natal cases handled and registered: 08

- ❖ RTI cases detected and treated: 200

ASSOCIATED ACTIVITIES:

- ❖ *On 20th October, an Awareness programme on TB and Diabetes in Gabi-Chumang. 30 people have benefited from this programme.*
- ❖ *On 5th July De-worming of students of St. Joseph's Primary School.*
- ❖ *1 mobile clinic in Gabi-Chumang for 20 people.*
- ❖ *On 18th August Health class on Personal Hygiene, nutrition and exercise given to students of St. Joseph's School.*
- ❖ *On 17th February' 2014, Administered vitamin A to all the age group in Char-gharey and Gabi-Chumang.*
- ❖ *Serious patients are referred to and accompanied to Kalimpong or Siliguri.*
- ❖ *On 22th February Health Class on Balanced Diet for guardians of boarders. The importance of cereals and its advantages.*



OBSERVATION:

- ❖ *There were cases of UTI, Gastro-entritis, RTI, Anaemia, Hypertension, Cancer and TB.*

SPECIAL CASES

1. **Miss Lina Tamang**, age 25 yr. from Godak suffered from Black tuberculosis. Three years back she was diagnosed as a TB patient. Due to lack of financial stability her medical needs as well as nutritional needs are seen by the Sisters. She has already lost her three sisters and two brothers. They all died of the same sickness. Right now she lives with her elder brother in Gangtok.

2. Mr. Kumar, Age: 54 from Bindu near border of Bhutan was diagnosed Cirrhosis of Liver. Mr. Kumar got admitted in our Dispensary with the complaints of breathing difficulty. After general examination it was suggested that he had to be hospitalized. He was accompanied to the hospital (SD Hospital Kalimpong) and all the basic needs were fulfilled by the dispensary. But due to financial problem he was unable to go for the further treatment. He was given financial support to go for further treatment and is recovering now.
